It should be noted, 7 of the 9 dogs euthanized in October, were at the owner's request. 4 due to the dogs being aggressive or having a bite history and 3 for medical reasons. The Shelter euthanized 1 dog for being aggressive and 1 for medical reasons.

As of Thursday, November 21th, 2024, there are currently 23 dogs at the Shelter. 22 are available for Adoption. 1 is on a 3-day stray hold.

10 of the available dogs up for adoptions were owner surrenders, 10 were brought in strays or dogs deputies picked up running at large, and 1 was put in our public drop off pens that are for after-hour stray dogs. 2 were seized and then became property of the county.

There are a total of 8 dogs on the adoption floor that have been at the shelter for over 60 days.

Special Notes and Information:

A total of 10 Citations were issued in the month of October.

Deputy Brian Weiser issued 3 citations for failure to confine. Deputy Tyler Moore issued 4 citations for failure to confine and 1 citation for failure to license. Dog Warden Brian Biggerstaff issued 2 citations for failure to confine.
