On November 4, 2024 callers reported a possible drunk driver traveling eastbound on Sparta Rd. The callers said they observed the vehicle drive all over the roadway, in and out of a ditch, and then he got stuck while attempting to turn around. A deputy responded with the assistance from an officer from the Fredericktown Police Department. The deputy located the suspect vehicle and quickly noticed signs of an impaired driver. After failing field sobriety tests, the driver was arrested for OVI with the suspicion of being under the influence of drugs. Medics were requested because the male became excessively tired and continued to fall asleep in the back of the cruiser. The suspect was cleared by medics. Inside the vehicle a loaded pistol and drug paraphernalia were found. The vehicle was impounded to the Sheriff's Office. The male was first transported to the Knox Community Hospital then to the Knox County Jail after he was medically cleared.
