AT&T Ohio respectfully withdraws its tariff application filed on December 18, 2024 in the referenced cases. We understand that there has been confusion and concern regarding the purpose and effect of the tariff update. The filing sought to update AT&T Ohio's tariff similar to all seven Ohio electric distribution companies and Frontier North, which have already received PUCO approval, consistent with long-standing Ohio Supreme Court precedent, to amend their tariffs to address cost recovery when a local government requires existing aerial facilities be moved underground for "beautification purposes" – not public safety. AT&T Ohio will work collaboratively with interested parties, including the Commission Staff, to address the issue with the goal of reaching a mutually satisfactory resolution of the issue.

We appreciate your understanding and look forward to constructive dialogue over the coming months.
