**SILENT BATTLE SPECS:**

- Approximately 220 pounds of bronze
- Approximately 42" fingertip to toe and 34" tall to top of head
- Estimate for bronze \$45,000 as of January, 2026
- 1/2 down to begin casting. Balance due upon pickup from foundry.
- Time required at foundry : 6 months

Base recommended: 52" octagon x 18" high.

Every installation and location may require different bases to match their park or grounds. Therefore, the base is not included in the purchase price of Silent Battle Monument.
